AR Central Registry will be going live with a Web Plus-Urological Cancer Reporting Project on February 27, 2006. Web Plus is a secure web-based application being used to collect cancer data from Urologists. The object of this project is to enhance the ability to collect complete, timely and quality data, with special focus at this time on prostate and bladder.

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Prednisone is given along with Chemo as part of the treatment, so make sure Hormone is coded.

Make use of the chart to determine Single & Subsequent Primaries for Hematologic Malignancies. This is very helpful. It has been found that Subsequent Primaries are being missed.

Remember to do thorough casefinding on all the newly reportable hematopoietic diseases that became reportable as of 2001. Recent casefinding audits revealed missed cases.

Please submit a non-reportable list to the central registry at least twice a year.

Remember this rule: In cases of non-treatment, in which a physician decides not to treat a patient or a patient's family or guardian declines all treatment, the date of first course of treatment is the date this decision was made.
