The Section of EMS and Trauma Systems is happy to announce the introduction of an online continuing education opportunity that is available to all EMTs at any level free of charge. In cooperation with the Section for Cardiovascular Health, the Arkansas Section for Workforce and Career Development and UAMS, the Arkansas Stroke Scale Training module is now available through a web-based distance-learning program known as A-TRAIN.

The attached flyer introduces A-TRAIN and instructs how to access the Stroke Scale Training module. After completion, a certificate will be printed that will be accepted toward Arkansas EMT recertification without needing any other approval. This will count toward the allowed twelve (12) hours of online continuing education credits allowed toward Arkansas EMT recertification.
