

Dear Limited Scope Examination applicant,

When you feel you are ready to take the Limited Scope of Practice in Radiography Examination, you will find enclosed, an **Application for the Limited Scope of Practice in Radiography Examination**. You are required to send your LSE testing fee of **\$100.00** (*ARRT testing fee increased from \$70.00 to \$100.00 effective January 1, 2008*) and your completed application to the address on the form. THE LSE APPLICATION FEE IS SEPARATE FROM THE TEMPORARY LICENSE FEE. Once your testing fee and your completed application are received by the RTL Program, your testing fee is forwarded directly to The American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT). This fee covers testing center costs for administering the Limited Scope Examination. The ARRT administers this examination solely for use by state agencies. State Licensing is NOT ARRT Credentialing.

ARRT will send you an **Examination Handbook**, which will provide you the necessary information on how to schedule your Limited Scope Examination via internet or by phone. All the information you will need to know about scheduling your **Limited Scope Examination** will be included in your LSE handbook. Please read it carefully! Your Limited Scope testing fee is non-refundable.

Content Specifications for the Limited Scope Examination are on page 16 thru page 23 of the **Limited Scope Examination Handbook**. I have included a copy of the **Content Specifications** with your Study Guide, Radiography Essentials for Limited Practice, to help direct you on what areas that you will need to cover in preparation for the Limited Scope Examination.

You will schedule your examination date and time. For your convenience, ARRT will assign to you, a ninety-day window to schedule an appointment to take your LSE. Please take note that the ninety-day window expiration date is **not** your Temporary License expiration date. It is simply a period of time that ARRT allows for you to schedule your test once your application has been processed. The Limited Scope Examination is a computer-based test that is all multiple choices.

ARRT will mail your test results to the ADH Radiologic Technology Licensure Program. We will notify you of your test results in writing. No test results will be given over the phone. The testing center will not give out test results to you.

You may schedule your Limited Scope Examination at any of the **Pearson VUE Testing Centers** in the following cities: Little Rock, Fort Smith and Texarkana. If you live in a border town, you may schedule your test at a **Pearson VUE Testing Center** in another state. Some of the cities that they are located in are: Memphis, TN; Springfield, MO; Tupelo, MS; Tulsa, OK; and Shreveport, LA.
