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INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. An approved application on file with the Plumbing Section at the Department of Health means a person is approved to take the plumbing inspectors examination to be certified.
- 2. Individuals applying for plumbing inspector certification will not receive a licensing card until such time the applicant attends the required training school. <u>Applicants must receive a confirmation letter</u> insuring their application is on file before attending a training school. Failure to have an application on file will result in not being approved for training.
- 3. All applicants shall take and successfully pass an examination before receiving a plumbing inspector license and shall not be eligible to perform plumbing inspections.
- 4. Plumbing Inspectors that fail to receive training within the prescribed timeframes, shall be become suspended and be required to reinstate their licenses. A yellow reinstatement application is required for suspended licenses due to failure to attend recertification training. These may only be obtained and submitted at a Plumbing Inspector Training Program.
