

## **Organization of the Law Book - How To Use The Index**

The Arkansas State Board of Pharmacy Law Book is composed of two sections. The first section is a compilation of pharmacy statutes related to the practice of pharmacy in Arkansas. The sections are labeled A through G and are footnoted. Specifically, the statutes are the:

- ◆ A - Pharmacy Practice Act
- ◆ B - Miscellaneous Statutes Related to Pharmacy
- ◆ C - Uniformed Controlled Substances Act
- ◆ D - Insurance Policies – Prescription Drug Benefits
- ◆ E - Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act
- ◆ F - Controlled Substances and Legend Drugs
- ◆ G - Administrative Procedures Act.

In addition, the Arkansas State Board of Pharmacy has formulated rules and regulations for the practice of pharmacy in Arkansas. Page numbering in the regulation section is in the form of the regulation number and page number. For example, regulation 1 is numbered from page 1-1 to 1-7; regulation 2 is numbered page 2-1 to 2-12. If a regulation is changed by board action, the entire regulation will be replaced. These rules and regulations are grouped as follows:

- ◆ Regulation 1: General Operations
- ◆ Regulation 2: Pharmacists
- ◆ Regulation 3: Pharmacy Technicians
- ◆ Regulation 4: Pharmacy
- ◆ Regulation 5: Long-Term-Care Facilities
- ◆ Regulation 6: Disciplinary Procedures
- ◆ Regulation 7: Drug Products/Prescriptions
- ◆ Regulation 8: Wholesale Distribution
- ◆ Regulation 9: Pharmaceutical Care/Patient Counseling
- ◆ Regulation 10: Pharmacy Support Group
- ◆ Regulation 11: Criminal Background Checks
- ◆ Regulation 12: Automation

The Index provides references to both the statutes and regulations for many commonly used terms and subject areas. For example, if you look in the Index for the term “fees” you will be referred to both the statute §17-92-108 on page A6 to A10 and the regulation 01-00-0007 on page 1-2 to 1-5. Some terms are found in only one area.
