Uninsured/Underinsured Assistance for Rabies Prophylaxis

Patient assistance programs that provide medications to uninsured or underinsured patients are available for rabies vaccine and Immune globulin.

 - Hypermunes Patient Assistance Programs. The program application is attached and below are the eligibility requirements for the program:
 - Annual household adjusted gross income of 250% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL) or less
 - Patients must be uninsured
 - FDA-approved indication
 - Only valid for residents of the United States, excluding Puerto Rico and other US territories
 - Under the care of a US licensed prescriber with an established practice located in the US
 - Patient may not be enrolled in Medicare, Medigap, Medicaid, VA, DOD, Tricare, or any other state or federally funded programs.

 - Additional considerations:
 - Physician must send in a letter of medical necessity that includes
 - Reason the product is needed
 - Amount of product requested
 - Length of time patient will need assistance
 - Explanation of patient's insurance situation
