1. Question: Does this grant program include vaping education and prevention initiatives as well as general tobacco use?

Answer: Yes. When we reference ENDS (Electronic Nicotine Delivery Systems) in the grant this is referencing the tool that is used to vape, so vaping is included.

2. Page 15 Section 3.C – Is the Maximum Weighted Score Possible correct?

Answer: No. The Maximum Weighted Score Possible should be 1050 points. The Information for Evaluation Rubric should be as noted below:

3. Question: My organization is a funded Project Prevent chapter. Are we still able to apply for this grant?

Answer: As long as your organization is a non-profit or school then you can apply for the grant. However, your current Project Prevent Chapter would not count as one of the two chapters needed for that county. The Project Prevent Chapter could still apply for funding from the Project Prevent Program at Arkansas Children's Hospital. If you were awarded the grant you would not be able use any of the grant funds for the current Project Prevent Chapter, but you could still provide assistance to this chapter.
